The CDA would like to encourage parents of dyslexics and adult dyslexics to set up groups in their areas. We will provide help and support and come out to the group to give a talk on dyslexia. If there is sufficient demand we will also help organise talks or workshops on specific subjects to do with dyslexia, in your area.

To get started you could talk to other parents at your school - if you don't know who they are why not do a letter to the school and ask them to pass it on to all parents of dyslexic pupils? If you go on one of our free Dyslexia Workshops for Parents, perhaps at the end of the course you could set up a group, even if to begin with it's just a few of you.

The CDA can post a letter out to any of our members in your area to advertise a new group. We can also provide the money to cover the rent of a space to hold the first meeting at, or of course you could meet in someone's house.

Adult dyslexics might like to start their own groups and again we will provide help and support and come out the group to give a talk on dyslexia. If there is sufficient demand we will also help organise talks with workshops on specific subjects to do with dyslexia, in your area.





To find other dyslexic adults try asking through Link into Learning, at college or your place of work. The CDA could perhaps put on a workshop specifically aimed at adult dyslexics and hopefully people who attend might be interested in starting a group.


The CDA can post a letter out to any members in your area to advertise a new group. We can also provide the money to cover the rent of a space to hold the first meeting at, or of course you could meet in someone's house or local pub!
