Dyslexia Awareness Training Workshop

This workshop is normally three hours long and can take place at your place of work or other venue. Workshop programme aims:

- to provide participants with an opportunity to acquire knowledge and understanding of dyslexia;
- to enable participants to gain a greater awareness of dyslexia and be able to give more relevant help and advice to adults and young people;
- to understand requirements for supporting dyslexics under the Disability Discrimination Act.

Cost £250 (Additional charges for travel costs and time apply depending on venue)
A certificate of attendance can be provided.

Dyslexia screening

The CDA can offer dyslexia screening which can be very useful in deciding whether you are dyslexic and also where your strengths and weaknesses lie. Some free screenings are available at the drop-in centre in Truro for individuals. Otherwise charges for screenings for employers and other organisations are as follows:

Screenings at the drop-in centre in Truro or place of work.

Basic screening for dyslexia. This will involve an in-depth session discussing your difficulties and how they affect you and will include a short letter outlining your dyslexic type difficulties. **£60**

(Additional charges for travel costs and time apply depending on venue)

Full screening for dyslexia (1 hour) This not only involves an in-depth session discussing your difficulties and how they affect you but includes an in-depth letter outlining all your strength and weaknesses and some suggestions as to how to overcome these problems. This may be acceptable as evidence of dyslexia in some situations and is also suitable for Access to Work claims. **£80**

Dyslexia Assessment this will be carried out by a dyslexia trained teacher with qualified assessor status and take about three hours to complete. It will involve a detailed series of tests and be able to diagnose whether you are dyslexic or not. You will be given a full report which is suitable for gaining exam concessions or providing evidence of your dyslexia for things like the Disabled Students Allowance available for HE students.

Spelling course for dyslexic adults (16+)

Are you dyslexic? Do you have problems with spelling? Did you find learning to spell at school just didn't work for you? Why not come to our friendly and relaxed spelling course delivered by a specialist dyslexia trained tutor Anne Betteridge. Anne - a dyslexic qualified teacher who has a lot of experience working with adult dyslexics and who has published a book on spelling. (*Chambers Adult Learners Guide to Spelling*) The course will consist of six two-hour sessions and there will be a maximum of 10 people on each course.



The approach will be a relaxed one using methods that have been found to work well for dyslexic learners and will also give you a chance to meet with other adult dyslexics who face similar problems.

Price to individuals likely to be in the region of **£70- £110** depending on numbers

Price for organisations wishing to buy in this course **£650**

One-to-one teaching

Also available from Anne one-to-one tuition for adult dyslexics (16+) at **£40 an hour**.

One-to-one sessions last for one hour and will be specifically tailored to meet your individual needs.
